- 4.) **ELKIN - JONESVILLE COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (TAB 2)**
Marc Allred of the Piedmont Triad Regional Council (formerly Northwest Piedmont Council of Governments) Regional Planning Organization will be at the meeting to present the Elkin - Jonesville Comprehensive Transportation Plan. As you may recall, we have discussed the plan at multiple meetings over the past several months. Mr. Allred will be asking the Council to consider the adoption of the highway map, the public transportation and rail map, the bicycle map and the pedestrian map. These are included as slides numbered 6 through 10 on the handout included in your packet behind Tab 2.

- 5.) **PARKS AND RECREATION TRUST FUND GRANT APPLICATION (TAB 3)**
Ron Niland and/or one of his associates will be at the meeting to describe the application for PARTF grant funds. The proposed application would be for funds to improve the Greenway. Specifically, it would be used to construct the pedestrian bridges over Sandyberry Creek and Fall Creek and to make other improvements to the greenway. The PARTF funds would be matched 50/50 by Town funds. We hope to secure funds from the Division of Water Resources

Water Based Recreation Grant Program to cover the Town's matching portion.

6.) APPOINTMENT OF TOWN REPRESENTATIVES TO ARLINGTON FIRE & RESCUE BOARD OF DIRECTORS (TAB 4)

In accord with Section 7 of the contract between the Town of Jonesville and Arlington Fire & Rescue, the Town is authorized to appoint two voting members to the Fire Department Board of Directors. The contract states that the *"appointments are to be made up of at least one of the Town Council's members and a third party who would be interested in the operation of Fire Department which will insure that the parties have good communications."*

7.) DISPOSITION OF FORECLOSED PROPERTY – 208 CARR STREET (TAB 5)

The Town's tax attorney, Mark Bardill, has completed the foreclosure process on the property located at or about 208 Carr Street. The Town placed a bid equal to the tax lien for the property (\$2,788.71). The Town is now the legal owner of this parcel of property. I would recommend that we have a survey performed to verify the property lines and to seek bids on demolishing the structure. The Town could sell the property as is, but it may draw more attention after the structure has been removed and the grounds cleaned up.
