Anita opened the meeting and asked Judy Wolfe to speak. She presented her projected budget needs for the Labor Day Weekend Festival and Flea Market Sept 5-7. (765.00) Promotional brochure (6 panel) 2000 copies to promote all Events/activities for 2015-16 (345.00) to be ordered from Vista Print. David made the motion, seconded by Danny and unanimous vote to approve \$500.00 for the Labor Day Festival. Danny made the motion, seconded by Debra and unanimous vote to approve the \$345.00 for a promotional brochure.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the May 26, 2015 and June 9, 2015 Budget Meeting. Gene made the motion, seconded by Debra and unanimous vote to approve the minutes from May 26 and June 9.

Scott reviewed the financial report for May 2015 with the Board and Gene made the motion, seconded by David and unanimous vote to approve the financial report.

Anita and Scott reported that we had an incident with Josephine Silvey from Roaring River Vineyards questioning the contract that she had signed with Profile Display for an Ad to be displayed in the Welcome Center. We contacted Profile Display for her contract time frame and contacted Ms. Silvey by registered mail with the details of her contract, she has not responded.

Anita discussed the double stack billboard on I-77 and that we should bring back some ideas for a new vinyl at the July 28 meeting. She agreed to call American Advertising to get a picture of the billboard that we have on I-77 in Statesville and contact Cathy Loftus at Douglas Displays to inform that trees are blocking the view of our sign (with the wine glass) on I-77.

Gary Niland reported that the Trails Grant opens June 26 for the second bridge on the Greenway. This bridge will be more complicated because it is on DOT property.

Scott presented a drawing of the proposed landscaping in the Roundabout on Hwy 67. The contractor will be responsible for maintaining the landscaping for 1 year and then it will be the Town's responsibility for maintaining it.

Danny made the motion, seconded by Debra to adjourn the meeting.
