motel owners want to make certain they have a schedule of pick up times for their out of town customers attending the Grape Festival. They discussed adding a 3rd van in order to not have a long gap in pickup times. This event will be discussed at the July 25, meeting and if needed make appropriations for additional funding. Jamie will attend the July meeting if needed.

Roundabout and Town of Jonesville sign

Michael agreed to get 3 quotes for cleaning and maintaining the middle area in the roundabout traffic circle on hwy 67. David made the motion, seconded by Gene, unanimous vote to approve up to 2,000 to get both areas cleaned up and then get a maintenance agreement.
