

**MINUTES

**SPECIAL MEETING

Mayor Pardue and all Council Members present except Council Member Moore.

Mayor Pardue called the meeting to order and led the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Council Member Darnell made the motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting June 9, 2014 and Council Member Green seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.

**CONSIDERATION OF BUDGET AMENDMENTS**

Council Member Green made the motion to approve the budget amendments for the 2013/14 budget year and Council Member Wall seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.

**DISCUSSION OF JULY MEETING DATE**

Council Member Green made the motion to not have a July 14, 2014 regular meeting and Council Member Darnell seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.

**APPOINTMENT OF ABC COMMITTEE**

After meeting with Elkin Town Manager Lloyd Payne to continue discussions of creating a merged ABC Board for our two Town's, we are recommending to our Town Councils that each Town appoint a committee to work together to attempt to work out the details of how such an organization may be structured. Elkin appointed Town Commissioner Bob Norton and Town Manager Lloyd Payne to the committee.

Council Member Darnell made the motion to appoint Town Manager, Scott Buffkin and Council Member Wayne Moore to the ABE Board to help work out details for the structure of the organization and Council Member Wall seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.

**INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY**

Staff was approached last week by a young man interested in doing an internship with the Town. Mr. David Jaynes holds Bachelor's and Master's degrees from ASU and wants to do an internship to gain some hands on experience in local government. Mr. Jaynes has offered to do the internship as an unpaid volunteer.

Council Member Green made the motion to approve David Jaynes as an unpaid intern for the Town of Jonesville and Council Member Darnell seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.

Council Member Darnell made the motion to purchase the John Deere HPX Gator 4 x 4 enclosed cab as an emergency vehicle for the Greenway \$9,500.00 and Council Member Wall seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.

**Note:** Council Member Darnell will bring the Gator purchase item up at the next TDA meeting to see if the Board is in agreement to help fund this purchase for the Greenway.

With no pending business to discuss Council Darnell made the motion to adjourn and Council Member Wall, seconded the motion, unanimous 3-0.
