The Town of Jonesville Board met for the Regular Board Meeting on Monday, May 8, 2017, at 7:00 pm in the Jonesville Town Hall.

Mayor Pardue called the meeting to order and led the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve the minutes of April 7, 2017, Special Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve the minutes of April 10, 2017, Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve the minutes of April 17, 2017, Special Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve and seal the minutes of April 10, 2017, Closed Session. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

### **OATH OF POSITION – TOWN MANAGER**

Michael Pardue comes to the Town of Jonesville bringing twenty-five years experience having worked with Wilkes County. On behalf of the Town of Jonesville, the staff would like to welcome him in this new position. Michael's skills, qualifications, and experience are going to be a vital asset to the Town in the years to come.

Mayor Pardue read the oath of position to Town Manager, Michael Pardue.

### **REQUEST TO ADDRESS COUNCIL – STEVE NEWMAN – GRACE CLINIC OF YADKIN VALLEY**

Steve Newman and Betty Taylor addressed the Board on behalf of Grace Clinic. Grace Clinic would like to request a 2017-2018 contribution of \$1,000 from the town. These funds would be used for direct care to their patients. Grace Clinic needs funding for purposes such as medical supplies, prescriptions from local pharmacies, and providers. They presented an active patients list by zip code and 16.3% are from Jonesville. No action was taken.

### **APPOINTMENT OF BOARD MEMBERS TO THE YADKIN VALLEY SEWER AUTHORITY (YVSA) BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Mr. Wayne Moore's term on the Board of Directors of the Yadkin Valley Sewer Authority is set to expire at the end of June 2017. The Sewer Authority has requested that we make an appointment by May 8, 2017. Mr. Moore has served well and may be reappointed if that is the decision of the Town Council. Under the bylaws of the Authority, any "qualified citizen" may be appointed to serve.

A motion was made by Council Member Green to appoint Mr. Moore to serve on the Yadkin Valley Sewer Authority Board for another term. The motion was seconded by Council Member Wall and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

### **RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY**

The Town has received an offer of \$250.00 for the surplus property located at 115 Foster Street. This property was acquired via tax foreclosure in conjunction with Yadkin County. Any amount received on the property will be shared with Yadkin County proportionally to the amount of taxes that each party was owed at foreclosure (minus any costs associated with advertising, closing, etc.)

A motion was made by Council Member Wall to approve the resolution to sell property by upset bid with the offer starting at \$250.00 located at 115 Foster Street. The motion was seconded by Council Member Moore and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

### **SET DATE FOR BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town Council needs to set the date for the public hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2017/18 budget. Staff recommends that the public hearing be held in conjunction with next month's regular meeting on June 12, 2017 at 7:00 pm. The budget may be adopted any time after the conclusion of the public hearing.

A motion was made by Council Member Green to set the date for the public hearing on the proposed FY 2017/2018 budget at the next month's regular meeting on June 12, 2017 at 7 pm. The motion was seconded by Council Member Wall and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

### **DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

The departmental reports are included in your agenda packet. The Council will need to make a motion to approve the monthly financial report.

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve the month of April's financials. The motion was seconded by Council Member Wall and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

### **CLOSED SESSION – PERSONNEL MATTER**

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to go into closed session to discuss a personnel matter. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

A motion was made by Council Member Green to leave the Closed Session and return to the Regular Town Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Moore and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve a \$5,000 bonus for Lynn Trivette during the time period as Interim Town Manager for the town. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

The Board asked Andrew Brown to write a letter to Mr. Woell and give him until June 1, 2017 to remove all personal belongings at the old town hall.

### **ADJOURN**

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to adjourn the May 8, 2017, Regular Board Meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Green and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.
