NC DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTION

Mike Petty-John with the NC Department of Transportation updated the Council and community regarding construction on I-77 and Highway 21 Bridge Replacement.

I-77 – project to extend from Exit 79 to Exit 83

- Rehab project approximately 4 miles
- Could start late December but most likely Spring due to concrete work
- Completion date estimated August 2021; hopefully 2 years
- Can work both north and south bound lanes at the same time up to contractor

Hwy 21 – project to begin after I-77 project

- Will replace bridge with offsite detours
- Cannot use temporary bridge due to cost and it would require remove of church property and house on hill above bridge
