

**TOWN OF JONESVILLE
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MEETINGS
September 10, 2018**

The Town of Jonesville Council met for the Regular Monthly Board Meeting on Monday, September 10, 2018 at 7:00 pm in the Jonesville Town Hall.

Mayor Pardue called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

There was no public comment during this time.

ADOPTION OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Council Member Moore to approve the minutes of August 13, 2018, Regular Town Council Meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Darnell and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0

CDBG GRANT

Town Manager Michael Pardue presented a Resolution for the CDBG Grant previously discussed during the Public Hearing. Michael requested the Council review and approves the Resolution so he could move forward with the process of the CDBG Grant application.

A motion was made by Council Member Green to approve the Resolution for the CDBG Grant. The motion was seconded by Council Member Darnell and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

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AIA GRANT

Town Manager Michael Pardue presented a Resolution for an AIA Grant. Michael requested the Council review and approves the Resolution allowing him to move forward with the application process for the AIA Grant.

A motion was made by Council Member Darnell to approve the Resolution for the AIA Grant. The motion was seconded by Council Member Moore and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0.

NC DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

A representative from the NCDOT was unable to attend the meeting. A representative is expected to be available at the October 8, 2018 meeting to discuss an update on the I-77 and Highway 21 bridge replacement.

JONESVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY

Librarian Barbara Gilpin presented to the Town Council information on the summer Libraries Rock program. There were 96 registered children, teens and adults who participated in the summer program reading 4093 books. Barbara thanked the Council and Community for the support. The library is open for homeschooling and public school children to use the online learning tools available. The library will be hosting an blood drive in October with the Red Cross. September is National Library Card Sign Up Month. Barbara brought applications to receive your own library card also stating that the library card is the first step toward academic achievement and lifelong learning. She requested the Town Council sign a Proclamation declaring September Library Card Sign Up Month for Jonesville. A motion was made by Council Member Darnell to reserve September declaring September Library Card Sign Up Month in Jonesville. The motion was seconded by Council Member Moore and approved by a unanimous vote. 3-0

MONTHLY FINANCE REPORT

The August monthly finance report was presented to the Town Council by Wendy Thompson, Finance Director. Wendy requested that the Council not approve the financial until next month since the Town is in the middle of the field audit. The financials will be brought before the Council in October for approval.

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DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS

Departmental reports were included in the agenda packets and verbally by the following:

Water/Public Works – Tim Collins, Director of Utilities
Police Department – Dane Mastin, Police Chief
Fire Department – Kevin Macemore, Chief Arlington Fire & Rescue
Manager's Report & Code Enforcement – Michael Pardue, Town Manager

Chief Kevin Macemore reported that there were 66 incidents answered by the department with 34 being within Town limits and 32 in the rural area. The members are training and working to take good care of the trucks and equipments at the department.

PLANNING BOARD APPOINTMENTS

The Town Manager presented the following individual to the Town Council for appointment to the Planning Board : Mark Parker. This position is currently a 1 year term with a subsequent 3 year term. Michael stated that as it has been discussed before the terms are set to stagger the terms of the members. A motion to appoint Mark Parker to the Planning Board was made by Council Member Moore. The motion was seconded by Council Member Darnell and approved by unanimous vote. 3-0

ARLINGTON FIRE & RESCUE ISO RATING

Yadkin County Fire Marshall Ricky Leonard presented before the Town Council along with Chief Kevin Macemore, the accomplishments of Arlington Fire & Rescue ISO Rating achieved. Ricky stated that the hard work of the members resulted in an ISO rating of five (5) district wide. He further stated the requirements by other agencies and the fire department for obtaining a rating from the Office of State Fire Marshall's office. The ISO rating of five can result in a decrease of insurance premiums for those located within that district. Ricky also displayed the cost of a firefighter to obtain the training and work completed through one year, including the numbers of calls answered.

Chief Macemore asked that the Board of Directors stand before the Council and those in attendance to introduce them self. Chief Macemore stated that the Board was instrumental in helping the department achieve this goal.

Chief Macemore then asked the members of the department to stand before the Council and those in attendance to introduce them self.

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

UPCOMING MEETINGS


